1. This form must be submitted (in person or by email at wyouthorchestra@gmail.com) to the WYO Executive Director on or before **September 21, 2026**.
2. Eligibility:
 - Be a performing member of the WYO Symphony Orchestra or Wind Ensemble.
 - Be available to perform the work with the WYO Symphony Orchestra during the Winter Concert on **February 7, 2027**.
 - The first place winner of the previous year, 2025-2026, is not eligible to compete.
 - Students are only eligible to win a maximum of two competitions during their participation with WYO.
3. Composition Guidelines:

The selected work must be:

 - One movement of a **original orchestral composition** work for a solo instrument and orchestra.
 - Arrangements, transcriptions, or adaptations of works are not permitted.
 - Approved by the WYO Symphony Director prior to start preparing the work with your instructor.
 - Each student must select a concerto that has not been performed by past winners of the orchestra in the last five years to ensure no concerto is repeated among Symphony members. A list of previously performed concertos is printed at the back of this sheet.
4. Competition Requirements:

Each candidate will receive 15 minutes of performance time and must:

 - Prepare the exact movement they wish to perform with WYO.
 - Make appropriate cuts if the work exceeds 15 minutes.
 - Provide an accompanist. You are responsible for finding your own and will be disqualified if you do not have one at the competition.
 - **Submit three printed copies of your instrument part to the WYO Executive Director by Monday, September 21, 2026.**
 - Memorization is required for the competition, which is also a concert open to the public.
5. All contestants and audience will be asked to vacate the recital hall after the final performance. The judges will deliberate immediately following the competition, and the winner will be announced that evening.
6. The WYO Symphony Director reserves the right to cancel the competition at any time due to minimal enrollment requirements not being met. Minimum enrollment = 2 competitors.
